

Dear Friends of the Coalition for Civil Liberties,

The California State Sheriffs' Association, an organization that gives one unifying and effective voice to the 58 Sheriffs around the state, has announced its opposition to the deceptively titled "Safety for All Act of 2016."

In a letter delivered to the Newsom campaign, the Sheriffs criticize the initiative for doing "little to prevent the criminal element from acquiring guns and ammunition via the black market or through theft...Effectively, this measure will create a new class of criminals out of those that already comply with common sense practices that now exist." When law enforcement officials speak out against a new rule or regulation, especially together like this, it's going to change a lot of minds. Nationally, the Pulitzer Prize winning <u>Politifact</u> also has taken note of Newsom's opportunistic campaign and lies about gun safety. Politifact rated his claims "mostly false" and wrote: "The problem with the way Gavin Newsom is using this pseudo data is it's out of context and is done in a way which is calculated to cause confusion."
