

Why gun owners should vote for John Kerry

Why gun owners should NOT vote for John Kerry

John Kerry voted for Ted Kennedy's proposal to outlaw most ammunition used by deer hunters.

Voted for Kennedy Amendment to S.1805 (3/2/2004).

John Kerry voted in favor of banning semi-automatic firearms, including many firearms favored by sportsmen.

Nine separate votes for gun ban legislation. Most recently, Kerry voted to amend S.1805 to include the Feinstein amendment reauthorizing the Clinton gun ban for ten years (3/2/2004).

John Kerry voted to allow trial lawyers to sue firearms manufacturers and hold them legally responsible for the acts of criminals – a vote that could bankrupt America's gun makers.

Voted to amend S.1805 to include gun ban legislation, effectively killing lawsuit reform legislation (3/2/2004).

John Kerry voted to close off hundreds of thousands of acres to hunters.

Voted against Wallop Amendment to S.21 (8/25/1994).

John Kerry supports higher taxes on firearms and ammunition.

On CNN "Late Edition" (11/7/1993) Kerry said "I think you ought to tax all ammunition more, personally. I think you ought to tax guns."

John Kerry's anti-sportsmen voting record has earned him the highest rating from radical anti-hunting and anti-gun groups.

Humane Society of the United States (not the American Humane Society), which wants to ban all sport hunting in America, called Kerry a "hero" for his anti-hunting record (see www.HSUS.org). Kerry has a perfect rating from the anti-gun Brady Campaign.

John Kerry voted to criminalize legal sales between private individuals at gun shows.

Lautenberg Amendment to S.254 (5/20/1999).

John Kerry claims he supports your right to own a gun. But actions speak louder than words. John Kerry's 20-year record in the U.S. Senate makes him the most anti-Second Amendment presidential nominee in American history. For more information on the real Kerry record on guns, visit www.NRAPVF.org.
